

# 2020 MGC Annual Meeting for 2021

## Meeting Highlights

Tom reviewed the events of the past year including our best event Member-Member. A motion was made to have Steve Arpaia, John Imbornoni and Paul Muzyk head up our Tournament Committee for 2021.

They were voted in unanimously.

Tom Bronzert will remain as President and Joe Macchia as Treasurer, nomination passed.
